

2014 MCCGA Scholarship

I. Application

- A. Each performing unit may submit <u>one</u> scholarship applicant approved by the unit director
- B. Applicants <u>must</u> be an active performing member of a unit that will attend the 2014 MCCGA Championships
- Applicants <u>must</u> be in their senior year of high school or currently attending college
- D. All applications <u>must</u> be typed
- E. Applicants <u>must</u> include high school or college transcripts and an explanation of the point system the school uses (i.e. 4 point scale)
- F. Applicants <u>must</u> turn in 2 letters of recommendation written by adults who are in no way related to the applicant. At least one of these must be an educator at their current school district or college.
- G. Applicants may represent <u>either</u> a MCCGA winter guard or winter percussion unit
- H. All applications must be postmarked on or before February 22, 2014
- I. The number of scholarships to be awarded will be determined by the annual budget and the MCCGA Executive Board
- J. The scholarship committee may choose to interview the scholarship finalists
- K. All materials need to be sent together

II. Criteria

- A. Grade Point Average
- B. Number of years involved in performance activities
- C. Essay- grammar, thoroughness of essay
- D. Neatness & thoroughness of application materials
- E. Future plans and goals
