Timing: Minimum 2 minutes/Maximum 4 minutes

WINDS

Flute/Piccolo, Oboe, Bassoon, Clarinet/Bass Clarinet, Saxophone, Trumpet, French Horn/Mellophone, Baritone/Euphonium, Trombone, Tuba

Timing: Minimum 2 minutes/Maximum 4 minutes

*Soloists may upload more than one video each solo weekend, but may not enter multiple solos on the same piece of equipment/instrument on the same weekend. Example: A guard member could enter a flag solo and a rifle solo, but could not enter 2 rifle solos on the same weekend.

Performer age limits will follow the 2020 rules. MCCGA will extend the eligibility for one year only during the 2021 season for performers who were members of Independent units during the 2020 season.

PERFORMANCE ORDER

Performance order each weekend except Championships will be by random draw. Schedules will be created in Competition Suite and the program will determine performance order for each class/round for those units registered each weekend.

Performance order at Championships will utilize the seeding method outlined in the 2020 MCCGA rulebooks.

To ensure each unit is evaluated fairly and equitably, a timeline schedule will be created for the judges that they must abide by.



VIDEO UPLOADS

Videos will be uploaded to Competition Suite. Uploads must occur no later than 11:59pm Central Time on the date listed in the UPLOAD BY column at the beginning of this document.

- -Videos must be one take. Spliced footage will not be accepted.
- -Viewpoint should be from an elevated perspective. Zooming in or moving camera is not allowed
- -Audio microphone placement is not restricted. Color guards may want to add an audio feed to their recordings.
- -A new recording is required for each registered weekend.
- -A staff member must hold a sign visible by the camera showing the date the video is being recorded prior to the beginning of the performance
- -Director's will be given information on how to announce the guard/program
- -Video recordings should start at the beginning of the announcement and end promptly at the end of the program

COMMENTARY/SCORES

Commentary will be available via Competition Suite as per the normal timeline. Scores will be released and published on the MCCGA website on the date listed in the SCORES AVAILABLE column at the beginning of this document.

Championships scores will be announced via Live Stream on 4/11/21. Time to be announced.

OTHER AWARDS

MCCGA will be awarding Scholarships during the 2021 season following the usual process. We will also be awarding a Volunteer of the Year Award, and recognizing our age out performers during the Championships Live Stream.

REGISTRATION

2021 Registration will open on **November 16, 2020** via the MCCGA website. Registration will close and all fees must be paid by **December 31, 2020**. Payment may be made via PayPal, check, money order or Purchase Order. *There will be no early entry for the 2021 season.*

MEMBERSHIP FEES

Solos: \$20 per entry per registered weekend

Competitive and Non-Competitive Group: \$85 per entry per registered weekend

*Units who chose the \$75 Champs credit at the end of last season will have that amount deducted from the total amount due at the time of invoicing/payment
