Schedule/Admission - Performances will begin at 10:00AM. Current performance times can be found in the directors packet, on hand outs, and at MCCGA.org. Our spectator entrance will open at 9:00AM. Admission is \$7 for adults, \$5 for children under 12 and senior citizens, and children under 5 get in for free!

Unit Parking/Check-In - Buses, trucks, and participants/directors driving themselves will park in our upper lot. Unit Check-In will be located at the main entrance off of the upper parking lot. Check-In will begin at 8:30AM. Units should be prepared to declare the number of performing members. Performing members will be given a wristband. Your unit will also be given 7 additional passes per MCCGA policy. Directors should wear their MCCGA badge. Additional staff or equipment crew beyond the 7 passes must purchase tickets at the spectator entrance located off the lower lot at the Gymnasium entrance. We will have student hosts that will assist you in finding your designated prop storage area and team member personal storage area. These locations are noted on the attached maps as well.

Tarp/Props/Equipment Storage -

- Unloading Tarps/props/equipment will be stored in the storage hallway. Large props that need more space, will be stored in the band room. Unloading will take place near the lower entrance near the spectator entrance.
- Loading After performing, we ask that units plan to load their floor/props to help clear space for groups coming in after you.

Spectator Parking - Spectators will park in the lower lot, with overflow parking to the upper lot as needed.

Unit Stations - Each unit will be assigned a section of hallway directly off the main entrance. There are several restrooms that can be used for changing and/or hair and make-up.

Music/Sound Check - We will have a CD player and aux cord available for use. Please be sure to bring your own dongle, as one will not be available for you. Sound checks will begin starting at 8:45AM and can take place during any break throughout the day.

Warm-Up - Body and equipment warm up will be in the Auxiliary gym. Each unit will use half of this space. Units will only be allowed to warm-up in designated warm-up areas. A warm-up schedule is in this packet.

Tarp Folding - Performers will take tarps to the wrestling room for refolding purposes. Units ending right before a break may stay and refold in the Performance Gym.

Performance Information - All performances will take place in the Performance Gym. We will be using a HORIZONTAL TIMELINE. Entrances and exits will be from the front right corner of the gym. Please follow all taping and padding guidelines listed on MCCGA's website.

Concessions - NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINK will be permitted in the school. Concessions will be available in the Commons.

Retreat - All retreats will be limited to two representatives per team per MCCGA's Covid Guidelines. Cadet and Scholastic/Independent Regional A retreat report time is 1:50PM. Scholastic AA/A, Independent A, and Independent Open retreat report time is 7:35PM.

Critiques - Will take place after each retreat. Critique schedule is inside the director packet and on the MCCGA.org website. Critique will take place in the FACS room.

Mask Policy - Francis Howell School district is currently not under a mask mandate, however per the MCCGA Covid-19 policy, masks are encouraged for all spectators, performers, and staff.
